Removes quickly and easily to reinstall factory pad and return mag to original spec. For low-stress applications where the mag will not be ejected onto hard surfaces. Use the L-shaped locking insert for extra-secure attachment and five additional rounds for 40S&W or an additional six rounds for 9mm. Overall magazine length will remain below 140mm for competition use.

Safety Instruction Guide for S&W M&P Extended Magazine Base Pad

Introduction

- **Capacity Limitations:** Be aware of the additional rounds that can be added: five for .40 S&W and six for 9mm. Do not exceed these limits.
- **Inspection Before Use:** Regularly check the base pad and magazine for any signs of damage, especially after being dropped or subjected to impact.
- **Proper Handling:** Always handle the magazine with care to prevent accidental ejection or dropping.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation:

- Remove the factory base pad from the magazine by pressing down on the locking mechanism and sliding it off.
- Align the S&W M&P Extended Magazine Base Pad with the magazine body.
- Slide the base pad onto the magazine until it locks securely in place.
- Ensure that the Lshaped locking insert is properly installed for added security.

2. Usage:

- Load the magazine with the appropriate number of rounds (maximum five for .40 S&W or six for 9mm).
- Insert the magazine into the firearm as per the manufacturer's instructions.
- Perform a function check to ensure proper seating and feeding of the magazine.
- Always keep the magazine pointed in a safe direction when loading or unloading.

3. Removal:

- To remove the base pad, press down on the locking mechanism and slide the base pad off the magazine.
- Reinstall the factory base pad if necessary by following the same steps in reverse.
