Safety Instructions for 1911 80 Series Extractor

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the 1911 80 Series Extractor. This product is designed for use with 80 series 1911 pistols and is made from extratough, machined steel for long life and reliable extraction. Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to ensure proper use and maintenance of your extractor, and to understand the safety precautions necessary for your protection.

- Ensure that you are familiar with the operation of your 1911 pistol before installing or using the extractor.
