Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Brownells #2 Roll Pin Starter Punch 5/64". This tool is designed to assist in the safe removal of roll or spring pins without causing damage to the pins or the punch itself. - #4, 1/8" (3.2mm)
- #5, 5/32" (4mm)
- #6, 3/16" (4.8mm)
- #7, 7/32" (5.5mm)

2. Preparing the Workspace: Ensure your work area is clear of clutter and distractions.

3. Using the Punch:

- Hold the punch in your dominant hand, keeping your fingers away from the striking area.
- Position the punch tip against the roll pin you wish to remove.
- With your other hand, use a hammer or mallet to gently strike the end of the punch.
- Apply consistent, moderate force until the pin begins to move.

4. Removing the Pin: Once the pin is loosened, you can usually remove it by hand or continue using the punch until it is fully extracted.
