Our handy, compact tool is uniquely designed to combine several tools into one. It has a spanner wrench that fits the receiver extension castle nut on M4-style collapsible buttstocks, with interchangeable pins to fit nuts with both old (round) and new (square) teeth, so you're ready for whatever type of nut is on the gun in front of you. Pins for both styles are included and easily changed by loosening a hex screw in the tool. For fixed rifle buttstocks, there's a screwdriver blade to remove the buttplate screws and a wrench for the nut on the receiver extension (buffer) tube. There's even a $\frac{1}{2}$ " square opening for a torque wrench, and even a hole for hanging the tool on your peg-board. Fits easily in a range bag or in your pocket for use outside the shop.

AR15/M16/M4 Replacement Pins Safety Instructions

Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the AR15/M16/M4 Replacement Pins from Brownells. This guide provides important safety information, usage instructions, and disposal guidelines to ensure your safety and the proper functioning of the product. Please read this manual carefully before using the product.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

Installation of Replacement Pins

3. **Insert the New Pin:** Align the new pin with the tool and insert it securely.

Usage of the Tool

- To use the spanner wrench, fit it onto the castle nut of the receiver extension and turn clockwise to tighten or counterclockwise to loosen.
- Use the screwdriver blade to remove the buttplate screws by turning counterclockwise.
- For the nut on the receiver extension tube, use the appropriate wrench to adjust as needed.
- If using a torque wrench, insert it into the $\frac{1}{2}$ " square opening and follow the manufacturer's torque specifications.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the tool and any worn or damaged pins in accordance with local regulations for metal waste.
- Do not dispose of the tool in household waste. Instead, take it to a designated recycling center if available.
- Ensure that any hazardous materials are disposed of in compliance with local laws.
