Introduction

- Insert the jag into the bore of the firearm and pull it through to clean the interior.
- Repeat as necessary, replacing patches as they become soiled.

4. PostCleaning:

- After cleaning, remove the cleaning jag from the cleaning rod.
- Clean the jag with appropriate materials to remove any residue.

- Store the cleaning jag in a safe and dry location.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of used patches and cleaning materials according to local regulations.
- Do not dispose of cleaning jags in regular household waste. Follow local guidelines for metal recycling or disposal of cleaning accessories.
