HANDGUN CLEANING KIT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Brownells Handgun Cleaning Kit. This kit is designed to help you maintain your handgun effectively and safely. This safety instruction guide provides essential information to ensure the safe use of your cleaning kit in compliance with the EU General Product Safety Regulation (GPSR).

General Safety Guidelines

- Always read and understand the instructions before using the cleaning kit.

- Wipe down any excess oil from the exterior of the handgun.
- Store the cleaning kit in its nylon carry pouch for safe keeping.
