Heavy-duty, 2-3/4" long polymer handle Hardened steel shaft Correct 3/32" steel pin punch for field stripping any Glock. The pin in the Brownells Disassembly Tool for Glock Pistols is made from the same hardened steel as our gunsmith pin punches, so it won't wear, peen, or (heaven forbid!) break while you're removing the locking block pin, trigger housing pin, trigger pin, and the magazine floorplate.

Introduction
