- Begin lapping with the abrasive material, ensuring to maintain even pressure throughout the process.
- Periodically check the progress to ensure the lapping is uniform.

4. PostUse:

- Clean all tools after use to remove any residual abrasive material.

- Store the tools in a safe, dry location away from children and pets.

- Dispose of any used abrasive materials in accordance with local regulations.
