Safety Instruction Guide for AR .308 Short Muzzle Brake

Introduction

- Use a wrench to tighten the muzzle brake onto the barrel using the 5/824 threads.

- After installation, perform a function check to ensure the muzzle brake is working correctly.
- Fire the firearm in a safe area, ensuring that the muzzle brake is functioning as intended.
