Introduction

It is virtually impossible to perform this task without this tool. Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to ensure safe and effective use of the product.

- Always use the PIVOT PIN DETENT DEPRESSOR as directed in this guide.
- Keep the tool out of reach of children and vulnerable individuals.
- Inspect the tool for any damage or wear before use. Do not use if damaged.

- If resistance is encountered, stop and ensure that the detent is fully depressed before proceeding.
