- Insert the selected pilot into the breech end of the Chamfer Tool Extension Rod until it is securely in place.

2. Usage:

- Position the tool securely against the workpiece.
- Apply steady pressure while operating the tool to ensure consistent cutting action.
- Monitor the cutting action to avoid runout and ensure effective chip removal.
- Stop using the tool immediately if you notice any irregularities in performance or if the tool becomes damaged.
