

Introduction

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Preparation

2. Disassembly of the Firearm

- Follow the Browning HiPower manual to safely disassemble the firearm.
- Remove the slide and recoil spring assembly from the frame.

3. Installation of New Springs

- Remove the existing recoil spring and hammer springs.
- Install the new FSW 17 lb. recoil spring by placing it in the same position as the original spring.
- Replace the hammer spring with the 32 lb. hammer spring, ensuring it is seated properly.
- If desired, install the RP 28 lb. hammer spring and the XP firing pin spring as per the specifications.

4. Reassembly of the Firearm

- Carefully reassemble the firearm by following the reverse steps of disassembly.

- Ensure all components are securely in place and functioning correctly.

5. Testing

- After reassembly, perform a function check to ensure the firearm operates safely.
- Conduct a test fire in a controlled environment, following all safety protocols.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any old springs and components in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of springs in regular household waste; check for recycling options or hazardous waste facilities.
