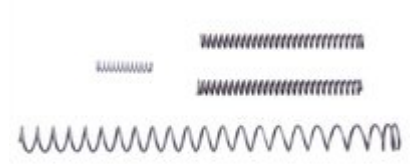

Introduction

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Preparation

2. Disassembly

- Remove the slide from the frame of the firearm.
- Carefully remove the recoil spring assembly from the slide.
- Take note of the original spring configuration for reassembly.

3. Installation of New Springs

- Replace the original recoil spring with the FSW 15 lb. variable recoil spring.
- Install the hammer spring by replacing the original with the 20 lb. hammer spring.
- If desired, install the RP 18 lb. hammer spring and the XP firing pin spring as needed.
- Ensure all springs are seated properly and securely.

4. Reassembly

- Reattach the slide to the frame of the firearm.
- Conduct a function check to ensure proper operation of the firearm with the new springs.

5. **PostInstallation**

- After installation, test the firearm in a safe environment to ensure proper function.
- Regularly inspect the springs and other components for signs of wear.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any old or unused springs in accordance with local waste disposal regulations.
- Do not incinerate or dispose of springs in a manner that could pose a risk to others or the environment.
