 - A "tweaked" action that may need adjustment.
- Make necessary adjustments and repeat the alignment check.

5. Final Steps:

- Once alignment is confirmed, proceed with mounting the scope following the manufacturer's instructions.
- Remove the SCOPE ALIGNMENT RODS carefully from the rings after use.
