Use Sights, Ribs Or Bases As Their Own Drill Jig

3 special Center Punches with outside diameters (O.D.) that match the clearance drill size of the most popular sight, rib and scope base mounting screws. Ground, parallel-sided punches reach through even the thickest handgun rib. Ends guess-work and hole center-to-center spacing problems. To Use: Level gun in vise or scope mounting jig, position and level sight, rib or base, and clamp in place. Place correct size punch in hole and lightly tap with a 4-oz. hammer. Remove base; drill and tap first hole; re-install base and check positioning. If everything is "square", re-clamp and finish other holes.

Introduction

- Position and level the sight, rib, or base where the hole will be punched.
- Clamp the sight, rib, or base securely in place.

2. Using the Punch:

- Select the correct size punch that matches the hole you wish to create.
- Insert the punch into the hole.
- Using a 4oz. hammer, lightly tap the punch to create an indentation.
- After making the mark, remove the base and proceed to drill and tap the first hole.
- Reinstall the base and check the positioning to ensure it is square.
- If everything aligns correctly, reclamp the base and finish creating the remaining holes.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the product in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of the tool in household waste. Check for any recycling programs available in your area.
- Ensure that the tool is rendered unusable before disposal to prevent accidents.
