Safety Instructions for S&W Cylinder & Hand Window Files

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the S&W Cylinder & Hand Window Files by Grobet File Co. of America Inc. This guide provides essential safety instructions to ensure the safe use of these tools. Please read and understand this document before using the product.

4. Carefully file the area as needed, ensuring to maintain control of the file.

Usage

1. Hold the file with a firm grip, using both hands if necessary for stability.
2. Position the file at the correct angle to the work surface to achieve the desired result.
3. Apply light, even pressure while filing to avoid damaging the workpiece.
4. Regularly check the progress and adjust your technique as needed.
5. Clean the file after use to remove any debris or filings.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the files in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of files in regular household waste if they are damaged or broken; check for specific disposal guidelines.
- Ensure that any broken pieces are safely contained to prevent injury.
