Together, they support the receiver in a ring of steel and greatly increase the amount of surface gripping area to totally eliminate twisted bolt ways or damaged, ruined receivers. This is the most advanced, complete, professional-quality, Action Wrench System. With it, you can prevent expensive receiver damage on MOST popular rifle actions, including military models, plus, models for selected handguns. Radius on head contacts and supports a full 180° of the forward receiver ring. Recoil lug fits in recess on base. Fits both pre/post '64 - actions.

Safety Instruction Guide for WINCHESTER MODEL 70/WEATHERBY MARK V COMPLETE WINCHESTER 70 ACTION WRENCH

Introduction
