With it, you can prevent expensive receiver damage on MOST popular rifle actions, including military models, plus, models for selected handguns. Two-piece head completely encircles cylindrical style action for 100% surface contact. Bottom Head indexes on the forward guard screw for extra holding power. Includes both heads and longer bolts.
