3. Using the Drive Extension

- If additional reach is needed, attach the 10" (25.4cm) drive extension to the Thandle.
- Follow the same steps as above to loosen the bolt or nut.

4. Using the Drag Link Bit

- Insert the drag link bit into the socket.
- Position the bit into the stock bolt hole.
- The round design will help center the blade for easier fitting.
- Turn the Thandle to remove the bolt.

5. Finishing Up

- Once the bolt or nut is removed, store all components properly.
- Clean the tools after use to maintain their condition.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any damaged or worn tools in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of tools in regular household waste.
- Consider recycling options for metal components where applicable.
