Introduction

- Use the ClipTip Law Enforcement Screwdriver Handle only with compatible bits to prevent breakage.
- Ensure that the #3005 MagnaTip Bit is securely attached before use.
- The 90 Degree Scribe should be used carefully to avoid injury from sharp points.
- When using the Beretta Pin Punch Set, ensure that your hands are clear of the striking area.
- The 1/4" Brass Drift Punch should only be used for its intended purpose to prevent bending or breaking.
- Handle the Beretta Magazine Lip Gauge and Magazine Lip Forming Pliers with care to avoid pinching or injury.
- Use the Series II India Stone and Series II Hard Arkansas Stone according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- The Beretta Trigger Return Spring Tool should be used with caution to avoid injury.
- Follow all instructions provided in the factory repair manual for proper use of each tool.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

- Before using any tool, read the specific instructions provided in the factory repair manual.
- Ensure that you have a clean and organized workspace to minimize the risk of accidents.
- When using the toolbox, ensure that all tools are properly stored to prevent damage and maintain organization.
- To use the Beretta Grip Bushing Staker:
 - Align the bushing with the grip.
 - Use the staker to secure the bushing in place.
- To use the 4oz Ballpeen Hammer:
 - Hold the hammer firmly by the handle.
 - Strike the intended surface gently to avoid damage.
- For the Beretta Bushing Driver:
 - Insert the bushing into the driver.
 - Gently tap the driver with the hammer to install the bushing.

- Use the ClipTip Law Enforcement Screwdriver Handle with the appropriate bit for screws.
- For the Beretta Pin Punch Set:
 - Select the correct size punch for the pin.
 - Place the punch against the pin and tap gently with the hammer.
- When using the Magazine Lip Gauge:
 - Insert the gauge into the magazine lip.
 - Check for proper fit and alignment.
- Follow the specific instructions for the Series II India Stone and Series II Hard Arkansas Stone for proper sharpening techniques.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any damaged or broken tools in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of tools in regular household waste if they contain hazardous materials.
- Consider recycling options for metal tools where applicable.
