Polished brass pilots turned to uniform concentricity make it easy to cleanup and square-off dinged or re-cut muzzles on 12 and 20 gauge, rifled slug barrels without damaging the lands and grooves. Use with Brownells 1" Diameter, 90°, Muzzle Facing Cutter for best results. Measure bore I.D. between tops of lands to determine closest pilot listed for your barrel. If your barrel's diameter isn't listed, select the closest, smaller size. Available in three diameters for 12 and 20 gauge, rifled slug barrels.

- If your barrel's diameter is not listed, select the closest smaller size.

### 2. Preparing for Use:

- Gather all necessary tools, including the Brownells 1" Diameter, 90°, Muzzle Facing Cutter.
- Ensure your workspace is clean and free of obstructions.

### 3. Using the Muzzle Facing Cutter:

- Attach the pilot to the muzzle facing cutter securely.
- Align the cutter with the muzzle of the shotgun.
- Turn the cutter gently to face the muzzle, ensuring even pressure and maintaining control.
- Periodically check the progress to avoid overcutting.

### 4. PostUse Care:

- Clean the pilot and cutter after use to remove any debris.
