Interchangeable pilot keeps cutter properly aligned. Purchase extra pilots to use one cutter for many different calibers. Pilots for other calibers available separately.

- Select the appropriate brass bore pilot for your caliber.

- Use the pilot to maintain alignment while cutting or chamfering.

5. PostUse Care:

- Clean the cutters and handle after use to remove any debris or residue.
- Store the product in a safe, dry place, preferably in its original packaging.
