Hex-drive shank allows the use of a standard square drive socket and T-handle.

Safety Instructions

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the SPIRAL FLUTE LONG FORCING CONE REAMER. This tool is designed to enhance your shotgun performance by improving pattern density and reducing felt recoil. 1. Align the reamer with the forcing cone area of the barrel.
2. Begin to turn the reamer slowly, applying even pressure.
3. Allow the spiral flutes to cut smoothly without forcing the tool.
4. Periodically check the progress to ensure that the reamer is cutting evenly.
5. After use, clean the reamer and store it in a safe place.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the reamer in accordance with local regulations for metal tools.
- Do not dispose of the reamer in regular household waste.
- If the reamer becomes unusable, contact a local recycling center for proper disposal methods.
