AR15/M16 Buttstock Cleaning Kit Safety Instructions

Introduction

- Repeat until the patches come out clean.

4. Chamber Cleaning:

- Use the bronze chamber brush to clean the chamber area. Insert it carefully and rotate gently to avoid damage.
- Wipe the chamber with a solventsoaked patch afterward.

5. Parts Cleaning:

- Use the doubleended parts cleaning brush to clean small parts and hardtoreach areas of the firearm.
- Ensure all debris is removed before reassembling the firearm.

6. Storage:

- Once cleaning is complete, store all components back in the nylon pouch.
- Ensure the pouch is securely closed to prevent loss of items.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of used cleaning patches and any hazardous materials in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of cleaning solvents or chemicals in regular household waste. Check for local recycling or hazardous waste disposal options.
