It will stick to ACRAGLAS®, but pulls right off with no damage to the tubing. Use it for forend tips, grip caps, cracked and split stocks & " Stocked in 2 weights. Type A is for light, multiple wrap jobs. Type B is for long pull or where greater tension is desired.
