 - Tighten screws in a crisscross pattern to ensure even pressure.
 - Do not overtighten; follow the recommended torque settings for your firearm.

3. PostInstallation Check:

- Once all screws are installed, check for tightness using the Allen wrench.
- Ensure that the triggerguard is securely attached and does not move.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any damaged or unused screws in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of screws in regular household waste; consider recycling if applicable.
- Ensure that screws are kept out of reach of children during disposal.
