# Safety Instruction Guide for SPECIAL LINE BRASS CORE RIFLE BORE BRUSH

## Introduction

- Insert the brush into the barrel from the chamber end, ensuring it goes through the entire length of the barrel.
- Move the brush back and forth gently to remove fouling and debris.
- Repeat this process as necessary, checking the brush for wear after several uses.

### 4. PostCleaning

- After cleaning, remove the brush from the barrel and clean it with a suitable solvent to remove any

residue.

- Store the bore brush in a dry place, away from moisture and direct sunlight.
