Safety Instruction Guide for SPECIAL LINE BRASS CORE RIFLE BORE BRUSH

Introduction

- Insert the bore brush into the rifle's chamber and push it through the barrel. Use a smooth, steady motion.
- Pull the bore brush back through the barrel to remove fouling and debris. Repeat as necessary for thorough cleaning.
- After cleaning, remove the bore brush from the cleaning rod and clean it according to the maintenance instructions.

4. PostUsage:

- Clean the bore brush after each use to ensure its longevity.
- Store the bore brush in a safe, dry place, away from children.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the bore brush in accordance with local regulations.
