Safety Instructions for the SPECIAL LINE DOUBLETUFF BORE BRUSH

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the SPECIAL LINE DOUBLETUFF BORE BRUSH. This product is designed to assist you in maintaining your firearms by providing effective cleaning through its highquality brass bristles. Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to ensure safe and effective use.
