# WOOL BORE MOPS SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

## Introduction

Thank you for choosing the WOOL BORE MOPS for your gun cleaning needs. This product is designed to help you maintain your firearms safely and effectively. Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to ensure the safe use of the product and to comply with the EU General Product Safety Regulation (GPSR).

- Insert the mop gently into the bore, ensuring it conforms to the rifling grooves.
- Pull the mop through the bore slowly and evenly.
- Repeat as necessary until the bore is clean.

### 4. PostCleaning Care

- Clean the mop after use and allow it to dry thoroughly.
- Store the mop in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.

## Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of used WOOL BORE MOPS in accordance with local regulations for hazardous waste.

- Do not dispose of mops in regular household waste if they have been saturated with cleaning solvents.
