Our nylon brushes stand up to these super cleaners and won't cause accuracy-ruining scratches. One-piece, looped and wound steel shanks (except Black Powder (BP) series, .17 caliber, and .20 caliber, which have brass shanks). SPECS: Bristles: Available in nylon. Shank: Steel, looped and wound.
