Safety Instruction Guide for COTTON BORE MOPS

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the COTTON BORE MOPS. These products are designed to assist in the maintenance of firearms by effectively cleaning the bore. To ensure safe and effective use of the mops, please read and adhere to the following safety guidelines and instructions.

 - Shotgun Steel shank, aluminum coupling
- Attach the mop to the cleaning rod, ensuring a secure fit.

3. Cleaning Process

- Moisten the mop with an appropriate cleaning solvent or oil.
- Insert the mop into the bore of the firearm, moving it back and forth to clean the interior surfaces.
- Use a new mop if it becomes excessively dirty or worn.

4. PostCleaning

- After cleaning, remove the mop and clean the firearm as per the manufacturer's instructions.

- Dispose of used mops and any cleaning materials responsibly.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of used COTTON BORE MOPS in accordance with local waste disposal regulations.
