The Ed Brown Concealed Carry Grip Safety is a modification of Ed's classic 1911 beavertail safety that gives you the benefit of the extended beavertail - protecting the web of your hand from "hammer bite" - without compromising compactness and concealability. The tail protrusion has been reduced by approximately 0.10". Also, the tail profile of the Ed Brown Concealed Carry Grip Safety has been machined to minimum dimensions, so you are free to install a standard Commander-style hammer, rather than having to buy a special (read, more costly) concealment hammer. Separate models for Series 70 and Series 80 1911 pistols (order carefully!) Fully machined from high-grade steel barstock Available in Blued carbon steel or natural matte silver/gray finish Stainless steel Gunsmith fitting required Series 80 requires fitting to .250" radiused frame ears The Concealed Carry Grip Safety from Ed Brown is the perfect choice for any 1911 pistol where the benefits of a beavertail safety are important but overall compactness and concealment are also a priority. Introduction

- Series 80 models require fitting to .250" radiused frame ears. Follow specific fitting instructions carefully.
- Use only standard Commanderstyle hammers for compatibility with this grip safety.
- Avoid using excessive force during installation to prevent damage to the firearm or the grip safety.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Preparation:

- Ensure that the firearm is unloaded and in a safe condition.
- Gather necessary tools, including the Ed Brown Beavertail Installation Jig (#087145886), if available.

2. Installation Steps:

- Remove the existing grip safety from the firearm.
- Using the Ed Brown Installation Jig, align the Concealed Carry Grip Safety with the firearm's frame.
- Carefully fit the grip safety to the frame, ensuring that it is seated properly.
- Check the fit against the hammer to ensure there is no interference.
- If fitting is required, proceed to fit the grip safety to the .250" radiused frame ears for Series 80 models.
- Once fitted, secure the grip safety in place according to the manufacturer's instructions.

3. PostInstallation Check:

- After installation, perform a function check to ensure the grip safety operates correctly.
- Verify that the grip safety properly disengages the sear when the grip is held.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any unused or damaged parts in accordance with local regulations.
- Ensure that all components are disposed of in a manner that prevents unauthorized use.
