This is the same as the Wide Ambidextrous Safety but with the levers trimmed to a 1/8" slender profile for better carry and concealment. This version is fully machined from stock for unbeatable quality and no chance of warping or porosity. This design uses a special hammer pin (included) to hold the safety securely, eliminating the need to modify the grips. Designed for all 1911 type frames and made from high quality steel. Available in blued or stainless steel. Requires minor gunsmith fitting for safe operation and includes complete instructions.

Safety Instruction Guide for Ed Brown Machined Ambidextrous Carry Thumb Safety

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Ed Brown Machined Ambidextrous Carry Thumb Safety for your 1911 handgun. This product is designed to enhance your firearm's safety and usability. Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to ensure safe installation, usage, and disposal of the product, in compliance with the EU General Product Safety Regulation (GPSR).

General Safety Guidelines

- Ensure safe use of the thumb safety by following these guidelines:

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation Steps:

- Ensure the firearm is unloaded and pointed in a safe direction.
- Remove the existing thumb safety from the firearm.
- Align the new Ed Brown Machined Ambidextrous Carry Thumb Safety with the safety slot on the frame.
- Insert the special hammer pin provided with the thumb safety to secure it in place.
- Check the movement of the thumb safety to ensure it operates smoothly.
- Make sure there is no interference with the grips.

2. Usage Guidelines:

- To engage the thumb safety, press the lever down until it clicks into place.
- To disengage the thumb safety, press the lever up with your thumb.
- Always check the thumb safety's functionality before using the firearm.
