- Always use a different wheel for each polish grit to avoid contamination.
- Avoid using the polishing wheels on wet or damp surfaces.
- Never touch the polishing wheel while it is in motion.
- Keep hands and clothing away from the polishing wheel during operation.
- Use the soft felt wheel for most work; medium or hard wheels should be used for 555™ Polish.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation:

- Ensure that the machine is turned off and unplugged before installation.
- Select the appropriate polishing wheel based on your polishing needs.
- Attach the polishing wheel to the machine's arbor, ensuring it is securely fitted.
- If necessary, use the supplied adapter to convert the arbor size to fit the wheel.
- Check that the wheel is properly aligned and does not wobble.

2. Usage:

- Plug in the machine and turn it on, allowing the polishing wheel to reach the recommended RPM.
- Apply the polish evenly to the surface being worked on.
