Use the soft felt for most work, medium or hard wheel for 555™ Polish.

Safety Instruction Guide for FELT POLISHING WHEELS

Introduction

- This product is intended for use by adults and should not be used by children.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

- **Installation:**

- Ensure the machine is turned off and unplugged before installation.
 - Attach the polishing wheel to the machine's arbor, ensuring it is properly secured.
