Use the soft felt for most work, medium or hard wheel for 555™ Polish.

Introduction

- Avoid wearing loose clothing or jewelry that could become caught in the wheel.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation:

- Ensure the machine is unplugged before installation.
- Select the appropriate polishing wheel based on your machine's horsepower and the desired finish.
- Attach the polishing wheel to the machine's arbor. Use the supplied adapter if necessary to fit the wheel securely.
