Use the soft felt for most work, medium or hard wheel for 555™ Polish.

- Use the soft felt wheel for most polishing tasks and the medium or hard wheel for specific polishes like 555™ Polish.
- Change wheels based on the polish grit being used for optimal results.
- Monitor the wheel for wear and replace it if necessary.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any damaged or worn polishing wheels in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of wheels in regular household waste if they contain hazardous materials.
- Consider recycling options where available to minimize environmental impact.
