AR15/M16 BRASSSAVR Brass Catcher Safety Instructions

Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the AR15/M16 BRASSSAVR Brass Catcher. This product is designed to safely collect and store spent .223 brass casings during shooting activities. Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to ensure safe and effective use of the product.

General Safety Guidelines

- Always ensure the firearm is unloaded before attaching or detaching the brass catcher.
- Use the brass catcher only with compatible ARstyle rifles, specifically those with a carry handle or flattop design.
