Self-centering Torx® screws help prevent slipping during use. Accepts Picatinny and Weaver-style rings.

FGFORCE SCOPE MOUNT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the FGFORCE Scope Mount by Farrell Industries. This guide provides essential safety information and instructions for the safe installation and use of your product. 2. Installation Steps

- Align the scope mount with the receiver of your Remington 700 Short Action.
- Insert the angled screw into the designated hole to create a recoil lug.
- Secure the mount using the selfcentering Torx® screws, ensuring they are not overtightened.
- Check that the mount is level and properly aligned with the firearm.

3. Usage Guidelines

- Once installed, attach your scope to the mount using Picatinny or Weaverstyle rings.
- After mounting the scope, perform a function check to ensure everything is secure.
- Before use, doublecheck the tightness of all screws and the alignment of the scope.

4. PostUse Care

- After each use, inspect the scope mount for any signs of wear or damage.
- Store the firearm and scope mount in a safe, dry place when not in use.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the scope mount in accordance with local regulations for metal products.
- Do not dispose of the product in household waste. Instead, utilize designated recycling facilities if available.
