# Safety Instruction Guide for AR15 30RD PMAG GEN M2 MOE WINDOW MAGAZINE

## Introduction

- Align the magazine with the magazine well of the firearm.
- Push the magazine firmly into the magazine well until it clicks into place.

- Press the magazine release button on the firearm.
- Pull the magazine out of the magazine well.

### 4. Cleaning the Magazine:
