Muzzle Brake helps you stay on target by venting gases upward to counteract muzzle rise for fast follow-up shots; improves control and accuracy during full-auto fire. Accepts most over-the-barrel sound suppressors and actually increases their effectiveness.

# AR15 Medieval Muzzle Brake Safety Instruction Guide

## Introduction

- Be aware of the increased effectiveness of overthebarrel sound suppressors when used with this muzzle brake.
- After firing, allow the muzzle brake to cool before handling, as it may become hot.

- Do not dispose of the muzzle brake in regular household waste. Check for local recycling programs or hazardous waste disposal options.
