Removes instantly by pulling the large, easy-to-grasp ring to clear the chamber and bring the weapon into operation. Use in any situation that requires fast, visual verification of firearm status law enforcement, military, gun shops, as well as hunting, range, and competition applications. Fits semi- and full-auto rifles and carbines with an extractor enclosed within the bolt, including AR-15/M16/M4 and M14/M1A. Flexible, one-piece, molded polymer construction stands up to years of insertion and removal cycles. Tab on pull ring allows marking with individual weapon identification information.

# CHAMBER BLOCKING DEVICE SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

## Introduction

The CHAMBER BLOCKING DEVICE is designed to enhance firearm safety by providing a clear visual indicator that a firearm is unloaded. This guide provides essential safety instructions, precautions, and information to ensure safe use of the device in compliance with the EU General Product Safety Regulation (GPSR).

## General Safety Guidelines

- Open the action of the firearm to expose the ejection port.
- Insert the CHAMBER BLOCKING DEVICE into the ejection port until it fits snugly.
- Ensure that the bright orange color is visible, providing a clear visual indication that the firearm is unloaded.

### 2. Usage:

- Use the CHAMBER BLOCKING DEVICE in any situation requiring fast visual verification of firearm status, such as during law enforcement activities, military operations, gun shop displays, hunting, or shooting ranges.
- To remove the device, grasp the large pull ring firmly and pull to clear the chamber. This action will allow the firearm to return to operation.

### 3. Post Use:

- After use, remove the CHAMBER BLOCKING DEVICE and store it in a safe location.
