Introduction

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Preparation:

- Ensure the firearm is unloaded and pointed in a safe direction.
- Gather all necessary cleaning supplies, including patches, cleaning solvent, and the ORING CLEANING JAGS TCS.

2. Attaching the Jag:

- Select the appropriate jag for your firearm caliber (e.g., .35, 9mm, .357, .38).
- Thread the jag onto the cleaning rod, ensuring it is securely attached.

3. Using the Jag:

- Take a round patch and moisten it with an appropriate cleaning solvent.
- Insert the patch into the jag, ensuring that it is pressed firmly against the jag's O-ring.
- Insert the jag into the firearm's bore, applying gentle pressure as you push it through.
- Pull the jag back out of the bore, removing the patch and fouling.

4. Repeat as Necessary:

- Repeat the cleaning process with fresh patches until the bore is clean.

5. PostCleaning:

- After cleaning, ensure that the bore is dry and free of solvent.
- Store the cleaning jags in a safe and dry location.

- Dispose of used patches and cleaning materials in accordance with local regulations.
