Springfield M1A 10RD Magazine Safety Instructions

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Springfield M1A 10RD Magazine. This guide provides important safety information and instructions to ensure the safe use and maintenance of your magazine. Please read this manual carefully before using the product.

General Safety Guidelines

- Always ensure that the magazine is empty before handling or cleaning.

- Continue loading rounds until you reach the maximum capacity of 10 rounds.

2. Inserting the Magazine into the Firearm:

- Ensure the firearm is on safe and pointed in a safe direction.
- Align the magazine with the magazine well of the firearm.
- Firmly push the magazine into place until it clicks.
- Check to ensure the magazine is securely seated.

3. Removing the Magazine:

- Ensure the firearm is on safe and pointed in a safe direction.
- Press the magazine release button on the firearm.
- Grasp the magazine and pull it straight out of the magazine well.
- Store or dispose of any remaining ammunition safely.

- Clean the magazine body and follower using a soft cloth.
