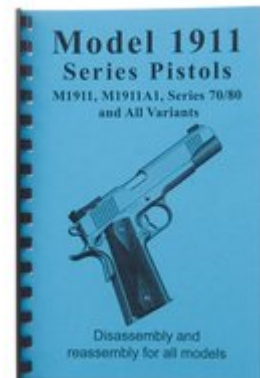

1911 Assembly and Disassembly Guide Safety Instructions

Introduction
