Fast Transitions From Two-Point To Single-Point Carry

Rugged nylon web sling works as a traditional two-point sling for comfortable hands-free carry, then transitions rapidly to single-point configuration if the mission dictates. Features a 9½" section of bungee cord that keeps the weapon tight to the body to prevent hang-ups; durable nylon sheath protects the bungee. Two steel alligator snap hooks with spring-loaded safety locks prevent unintentional release, yet allow fast changes from two- to single-point use. Polymer quick-release buckle instantly opens the sling for emergency egress. Polymer adjustment buckles enable easy fit over tactical vests and other gear. Two steel D-rings allow optional advanced single-point configurations. The "QD" is equipped with popular QD connectors and innovative female QD. QD's provide quiet, fully fluid connection that's that hold perfectly, release quickly, and give maximum flexibility. This set-up gives you the ability to do lightning fast conversions from single point to 2-point, plus the "limited bungee" locks out at about 6" to give firm shooting support if needed and will never breakdown.

AMBI SLING Safety Instructions

Introduction

- Avoid using the sling in situations where it could become entangled or snagged on objects.
- Do not exceed the recommended weight limits for the sling to prevent failure during use.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation:

- Attach the two steel alligator snaphooks to the designated attachment points on your firearm or tactical gear.
- Ensure that the springloaded safety locks on the snaphooks are fully engaged.
- For singlepoint use, utilize the two steel Drings to configure the sling as needed.

2. Adjusting the Sling:

- To adjust the length of the sling, use the polymer adjustment buckles. Pull the webbing through the buckle to achieve the desired length.
- Ensure the sling is snug but comfortable against your body.

3. Using the Sling:

- For twopoint configuration, allow the sling to rest comfortably across your body, ensuring that it does not obstruct movement.
- To switch to singlepoint configuration, release the snaphook from the attachment point and reattach it to the Dring.
- Always check that the sling is secure before use.

4. Emergency Egress:

- In case of an emergency requiring rapid removal of the sling, use the polymer quickrelease buckle to detach quickly.

Disposal Instructions

- When the sling reaches the end of its usable life or is damaged beyond repair, dispose of it responsibly.
- Check local regulations for disposal of nylon and polymer materials.
- Do not dispose of the sling in a manner that could pose a risk to the environment or public safety.
