Kits available in easy-to-install. Weld/Solder model. Installation requires machining the pistol frame and minor modification to standard grip panels. MaxBevel mainspring housing provides a longer magwell opening for easy reloading without adding bulk. Extra metal at the rear bevel allows shaping to a seamless fit in the factory magwell. Helps the shooter hit the "sweet spot" at the rear of the magwell during combat reloads.
