Introduction

This heavyduty tool is designed for the safe and effective removal and installation of the proprietary barrel nut on the Colt LE6940 Advanced Law Enforcement Carbine (ALEC). Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to ensure proper use and maintenance of the product.

General Safety Guidelines

- Always inspect the Armorer's Wrench before use for any signs of damage or wear.

- Turn counterclockwise to remove.

- If the tool is damaged beyond repair, consider recycling metal parts if possible.
