C130 Uberti Old Model P 1873 Grips - Also Fits New Sheriff, 7th Cav & Artillery & New Model Uberti Cattleman. Does NOT Fit Old Model Uberti Cattleman or Uberti Cattleman Hombre. Does Not Fit Cimarron & Taylor Firearms.

Introduction
